

Report of the Rules and Order of Business Committee

Kay County Republican Convention, Ponca City, Oklahoma

March 1, 2025

The report of the Committee on Rules and Order of Business to the Convention is as follows:

1. The Conduct of the Convention shall be under the rules of Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, except where those rules are in conflict with the rules of the Oklahoma Republican Party, or with the rules set forth in this report.
2. Only delegates registered by the hour of 11 a.m. Saturday, March 1, 2025 will be allowed voice or vote in this convention.
3. Each precinct shall report the number of ballots cast for each candidate for a computerized tally of the allocated votes for each candidate from that precinct.
4. No delegate shall be allowed to carry more than two votes.
5. All Rule Changes, Platform planks and Resolutions passed at the precinct meetings shall be brought to the floor of the convention.

Similar rule changes, platform planks and resolutions from different precincts shall be amended to be combined or selected between by vote, before a vote to accept or reject the motion.

Only germane amendments will be allowed on the floor. The Chair may rule an amendment not germane by objection.

Debate on any rule change, platform plank, resolution, or amendment shall be limited to ten minutes, alternating, and equally divided between proponents and opponents. The Chair may extend discussion for more than ten minutes if deemed necessary. The extension will also be equally divided.

The County Chairman and Vice Chairman may jointly make minor edits to correct grammar, punctuation, and spelling before publishing and forwarding to the state office.

6. Additional delegates to the State Convention may be added by the joint approval of the County Chairman and Vice Chairman with a legitimate excuse for their absence from this convention.
7. The order of business of this Convention shall be as indicated on the program. The Convention chair may make changes in the order of business to promote continuity and keep the pace of the convention going smoothly.
8. The Minutes of this convention shall be referred to the County Committee for approval.
